One of the first steps to any financial aid for school is filling out and submitting the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) **after January 1**. You will need a PIN which serves as an electronic signature for all the time you are in school. If you have not already done so, get your PIN by answering a few questions at www.pin.ed.gov. Your parents will also need a separate PIN when you fill out the FAFSA. Mark your calendar for the Financial Aid Workshop **Jan.13, 2010, in the theater at 7:00 pm.**
