

Unified board to meet tomorrow

Board will discuss contract terms for interim superintendent

The board of trustees for the newly formed Yosemite Joint Unified School District will hold a special meeting tomorrow at 6:30 p.m. at the Yosemite High School board room.

The occasion marks the second time board members will meet since voters approved Measure P during the Nov. 8 special election, giving the green light for the unification of the Yosemite Joint Union High School District with the Coarsegold Union School District.

The items on Thursday's agenda include the consideration of procedures to develop bylaws and maintenance of records, consideration of the official mailing address and telephone number of the district, as well as a discussion in closed session regarding a deliberation on contract terms for Bill McCabe, the district's interim superintendent.

The next meeting is Jan. 24 at 6:30 p.m. in the board room.
