YHS alumni game will be sponsored by new boosters club

The YHS baseball season will soon be underway, which means it's time for the third annual alumni baseball game featuring MLB All-Star pitcher Ted Lilly. This year the game will be sponsored by the newly formed Yosemite Baseball Boosters. It will be held on Saturday, Feb. 10 at 12:30 p.m. at the varsity baseball field.

The ticket price is \$10 and every ticket holder present will be entered in a drawing for a Central Coast two-night getaway.

There will also be a barbecue and live auction during and after the game. Auction items include: a handsigned baseball by Oakland A's pitcher Huston Street, four field level tickets to an A's game, Tenaya Lodge overnight, portable generator, party barge on Bass Lake with BBQ and shade, baseball memorabilia, western theme items from Rust Bros.

In conjunction with the alumni game, there will be a Youth Baseball Clinic held at the junior varsity baseball field on Saturday, Feb. 10, from 9 a.m. until noon.

The clinic will include the fundamentals of catching, throwing, pitching and hitting, as well as advanced techniques used at the high school level. The fee is \$30 per player and will include a participation T-shirt, lunch, and admission to the alumni game.

Ted Lilly is slated to help out with the clinic, along with YHS coaches and players.
