October 3, 2005**

1. Call to order: Betsy Blum called the meeting to order at 3:18 p.m.

3. Approval of September 13, 2005 Minutes: Steve Raupp moved and George Stillman seconded the motion. Vote carried unanimously.

**Approval of School Plan**

Steve Raupp reviewed the key elements of the document with the SIP committee. He defined the School Accountability Report Card and explained that this document is imbedded in the School Plan. Specifically, he reviewed the School Goals for Improving Student Achievement, the Annual Measurable Objectives as stated by No Child Left Behind, CAHSEE performance goals and the goal to improve test scores of our socio-economically disadvantaged student population. Steve explained that we are adopting the essence of the plan and that the plan will go to the board, be completed and that we will see the document again when it is completed. After discussion, George Stillman moved and Becky Stolp seconded the motion to approve the School Plan. Vote carried unanimously.

**Budget**
