

**Yosemite High School
SIP Minutes
October 2, 2006**

Call to order: Deborah Brown called the meeting to order at 3:16 p.m.

Roll Call: George Stillman, Mary Chirolo, Jill Althizer, Becky Stolp, student Sarah Prince, student Haily Abbott, student Christine MacLaggan, Steve Raupp, Deborah Brown, Betsy Blum and guest Earlene Ward

Approval of September 11, 2006 Minutes: Deborah Brown noted it was Steve Raupp who nominated her to Vice Chairperson and Tony Mower seconded. Steve Raupp moved to approve the agenda with these corrections and Mary Chirolo seconded the motion. Vote carried unanimously.

Approval of the October 2, 2006 Agenda: George Stillman moved to approve the agenda and Haily Abbott seconded the motion. Vote carried unanimously.

Review of Bylaws – Betsy Blum: Betsy Blum handed out “School Based Coordination Committee Bylaws” and requested SIP members to read over bylaws for discussion/approval at the next meeting. Discussion centered on possibly getting an “emergency action” section added as this is not addressed in the present bylaws.

Approval of School Plan – Earlene Ward: Earlene Ward presented the Yosemite High School Single Plan for Student Achievement, September 2006 Revision to SIP members for approval. The Plan’s Forms A, B, C, and D were reviewed. Steve Raupp suggested adding words to reflect more specifically how Title II funds are used. Presently, under Form C, Federal Programs under No Child Left Behind (NCLB) Title II, Part A: Teacher and Principal Training and Recruiting; Purpose reads: “Improve and increase the number of highly qualified teachers and principals.” The new words would add the how – ‘workshops/conferences, in-house training and substitute teachers costs for teachers out of the classrooms.’ George Stillman moved to approve the plan with these additional words and Betsy Blum seconded. Vote carried unanimously.

New Business: New Business centered on what would appear on next month’s agenda - SIP membership; Title I update by Consuelo Mercier; and Parents Surveys.

Budget Update: Steve Raupp first reported ‘we forgot him’ and that we went to New Business instead of what was reflected on the Agenda, his presentation of the Budget. After Steve Raupp’s review, members were told an approval vote wasn’t necessary as the Budget is gone over with SIP members a few times during the course of the school year when budget changes are made.
