

**Yosemite High School
SIP Minutes
May 7, 2007**

Call to Order: Tony Mowrer called the meeting to order at 3:18 p.m.

Roll Call: George Stillman, Tony Mowrer, Mary Chirolo, Becky Stolp, Jill Althizer, Scott Males and Jeanne Ratchford

Audience of Visitors: Greg Hill attended on behalf of Steve Raupp

Approval of April 9, 2007 Minutes: Mary Chirolo moved to approve the minutes and George Stillman seconded the motion. Vote carried unanimously.

Approval of the May 7, 2007 Agenda: George Stillman moved to approve the agenda and Jeanne Ratchford seconded the motion. Vote carried unanimously.

Prioritize and Finalize SIP Proposals for 2007 – 2008

Prior to beginning this discussion George Stillman asked if there were any carryover funds from 2006 – 2007. Chairperson Tony Mowrer indicated he did not know and we would be using the \$104,000 figure to finalize SIP proposals.

Tony Mowrer then read a long note from Librarian Betsy Blum who stated 4 computers are not working in the library. Prior to this month's SIP meeting, Betsy Blum had her \$9,000 computers-for-library request in the B priority column (funded case-by-case basis if funds were available). Betsy proposed \$4,500 of the \$9,000 be placed in the A priority column (most likely would get funded) to fund new library computers. After a lengthy budget discussion and a telephone call placed to Earlene Ward, director of special programs, it was decided to put \$4218.00 for library computers in the A priority column. Earlene Ward indicated the district may pick up the STAR testing snacks tab which amounted to \$2,000. If this was the case then SIP council members agreed to put this \$2,000 in the library computer fund bringing the total to \$6218.00.

Becky Stolp then moved to finalize the SIP proposals for 2007 – 2008 and Jill Althizer seconded. Vote carried unanimously. Following is how the final list looked:
