Dear Yosemite High School Parents & Students:

The summer is coming to a close and we are looking forward to the beginning of the 2005-2006 school year. Last year was another exciting year for Yosemite High School, with a number of outstanding accomplishments by students, both academically and in our extra-curricular programs. We will be looking forward to having yet another outstanding school year.

Enclosed you will find an Emergency Procedure Card, which needs to be completed and returned to the school in order for us to update our records. New cards must be completed each year to meet our record keeping and reporting responsibilities as a public school and to properly care for your student should an emergency arise. This information must be on file when classes begin in August.

All new students and 9th grade students will receive their schedules at the New Student Orientation on Thursday, August 18th. Information regarding the New Student Orientation will be mailed to you this week.

Schedules for 10th, 11th, and 12th grade students will be available in the front office beginning Monday, August 15th and may be picked up between the hours of: 8:30 a.m. - 3:00 p.m. when you turn in your Emergency Procedure Card.

All students will pick up their final schedule on the first day of school, August 22nd.

Please note: We must have a current Emergency Procedure Card on file for every student enrolled at Yosemite High School. You must complete the attached Emergency Procedure Card and return it to the office in order to pick up the student's class schedule. Also, any student who has outstanding textbooks or other obligations must clear those prior to receiving their schedules.

The counseling staff will be available on a first come, first served basis on August 16th, 17th, and 18th to register new students and make schedule changes. When school begins, counselors will be available at lunch and after school for schedule changes.

The first day of school is Monday, August 22nd, at 7:50 a.m. At that time, students will pick up their final class schedules followed by an assembly in the gymnasium. Parents and students are reminded that Yosemite Union High School District has established dress standards that students are expected to meet. Students who are not dressed appropriately for school will be sent home. A complete set of the Yosemite High School dress standards are included in your Student-Parent Handbook.

Again, I would like to welcome all new and returning students to Yosemite High School. We have an outstanding student body and we encourage all students to get involved in the wide range of positive experiences that are offered at Yosemite High School. Involvement in activities, athletics, and especially the academic program makes the high school experience a complete one. I look forward to seeing all of you on August 22nd.
